This Mother's Day, we walk with you. Mothering is not for the faint of heart and we have real warriors in our midst. We remember you.




Outdoor Worship & Bagels One Worship Service at 9:45 a.m.

Guests who come to the Abiding Presence Food Pantry receive produce, meat, dairy, eggs, snacks and assorted other items. We feed roughly 200 households at each pantry distribution.

Snacks are donated in-kind. Drop off at the church anytime individually prepackaged snacks and one gallon Ziploc bags. We are always in need of more snacks!
